In order to facilitate a smooth transition of employees electing relocation to the Dayton Region, as result of Project Walter, The Dayton Development Coalition will coordinate services to support Accompanying Spouses.

Accompanying Spouse services are meant to provide support for spouses of this project by quickly connecting them with community resource partners that specialize in career transition services.

The Dayton Region has a vast network of resource partners that includes:
Community Colleges;

- University Career Services Offices;
- One-Stop Workforce Centers;
- Outplacement Firms;
- Private Employment Agencies;
- and Community Support Groups.

Career transition services will assist in developing an effective reemployment strategy and increase the likelihood of connecting with the right companies in the Dayton Region.

Our community has experienced great success with these services in the past. In fact, during the 2005 Air Force Base Realignment and Closure (BRAC), the Dayton Region formed a committee to assist individuals and their families who had the opportunity to relocate from Brooks and Holloman Air Force Bases to Wright-Patterson Air Force Base. 20% of civilian personnel were expected to transfer. As a result of our regional collaboration, more than 40% chose to relocate.
